

# Basic Instruction Card AR-500



The Basic Instruction Card includes common instructions for optimal use of the Ceiling Hoist. This is not a replacement for the user manual! Before use, please read the manual carefully!

### Charging


The Ceiling Hoist charges when the hand control is placed in the wall charger.

- 1. Put the hand control in the wall charger.
- 2. Make sure that the charge indicator on the hand control lights up green.
- If the hoist is been activated, check the control lightning of the Ceiling Hoist flashes.




### Control lighting and sound signal.

The control lights show the status of the batteries and or they need to be charged.



**Green**: batteries are fully loaded.




Orange: batteries need to be charged. Every 10 seconds a beep.



Red: the Ceiling Hoist need to be charged immediately! Every 1 second a beep. Spreader Bar (lifting belt) can be lowered.







Before the lowering function starts to work, a weight, such as the Spreader Bar, should be hanged on the lifting belt.



Please, do not use the hand control and the Spreader Bar cable as drag cord!

## **Emergency break and emergency lowering function**

- Pull the red emergency cord to immediately turn off the Ceiling Hoist.
- 2. Keep pulling the cord, to slowly lower the Spreader Bar. The lowering function stops when the cord is being released. The Ceiling Hoist is now turned off.
- 3. To activate the Ceiling Hoist; press the button 'Ceiling Hoist on' on the hand control.
